

BEYOND MEXICO

In addition to the **\$11 million** granted to Mexico in FY2020, we also granted nearly **\$4.5 million** to organizations in **13 countries** in other regions of Latin America.

Barbuda

6 GRANTS – \$97,320

- To support COVID-19 Rapid Response efforts
- To support local farmers to help increase the availability of sustainably grown organic vegetables
- To support youth afterschool center for community members

Honduras

6 GRANTS – \$756,889

- To promote youth entrepreneurship and economic opportunities for adolescents in Huehuetenango, Quetzaltenango y Quiche, Guatemala
- To support the Sistema de Aprendizaje Tutorial (SAT) experiential learning high school program in 12 states of Honduras in 2020-2021.
- To support a program providing training in personal development, leadership, vocational and entrepreneurial training for youth in southern Honduras.
- To strengthen food security, improve living conditions and support family-based microenterprises
- To support the ecosystem of small and medium businesses in Honduras through the Transforming Market Systems (TMS) program.
